Thank you for attending the 2019 Brisbane Netball Association Representative Carnival!  
We hope you have an enjoyable day.

Please read the following important information –

#### **PARKING**

Given the recent wet weather, it is unlikely that Bradbury Park will be open for parking. If the park dries up before Sunday then Bradbury Park may be open for parking and entrance is via Allan/Batten Streets. A decision will be made in regards to whether or not we will open the additional park on Saturday. This will be posted to our facebook page. If the park area is open then parking is only available in the area near the Allan/Batten St carpark and cars are not permitted to drive through the park and up to the court area. The SES will be the car park marshals and would appreciate a gold coin donation. Please support those who support our community.

There is also parking available in the surrounding streets however please be respectful of our neighbours. Please obey the traffic rules and do not park across driveways, along yellow lines or in non-parking areas. The Police will be on patrol handing out fines and cars will be towed if they are parked across driveways.

We suggest that you allow plenty of time to find a park in the neighbouring streets.

Please note: trailers/buses must be parked in the overflow car park accessed via Allan/Batten Streets.

#### **GAMES**

All games will be centrally timed with 9 minute halves, 1 minute break at half time and 2 minutes between games. The first round commences at 8am and the last round will conclude at 4.47pm.

#### **DIVISIONS & DRAW**

Teams have generally been allocated into divisions based on their indicated strength as listed on the nomination form. Unfortunately we simply could not put all teams in their nominated division. As such we have considered past results including results from State Age in 2018 and tried to make the divisions as fair as possible. The 17 and 19 years divisions are combined. We appreciate your understanding in regards to this. Attached is a spreadsheet outlining the divisions. #### **UMPIRING**

Each team shall provide one competent umpire, who shall umpire each game the team plays. Any issues regarding the standard of any umpire need to be directed to the Association supplying the umpire.

#### **WEATHER**

We have all-weather courts and therefore play will continue through most weather conditions. If the BNA deems that weather precludes play from continuing then teams will be advised over the PA system. Umpires are not permitted to cancel individual games at their discretion. Any updates in regards to weather will be put on our facebook page.

#### **INJURY TIME**

No injury time will be added to any game. Therefore, in the event of injury, sickness or blood, the player is to come off immediately (or as soon as safely possible) so that they can receive appropriate medical attention. They may be replaced immediately. However, if the team chooses not to replace the player, they may return to the court as per AANA rules. We have first aid provided by the crew from Activate Physiotherapy and this is located in the BNA clubhouse. If there is an ambulance called to the courts, please advise the BNA personnel in the clubhouse immediately so that arrangements can be made for easy access.

#### **BORROWING PLAYERS**

It is expected that players play for one team only during the carnival. If through injury or illness, a team loses players during the course of the day, players may be borrowed from another team provided that:

1. Players borrowed must be in a lower division.
2. Players may play only 2 games out of their team. If they play 3 games then they must remain in the higher division.

## SCORE CARDS

Players are only required to sign the scorecard for the first game they play of the day. Players are not required to sign the scorecard for each and every game. The first named team is the official scorer; the second named team is the check scorer. Both scorers are to stand or sit together during the game. Once the result is finalised, a member from the winning team is to return the scorecard to the office as soon as possible. PLEASE LEAVE THE CLIPBOARD AT THE COURT, AS THIS WILL HAVE ALL OF THE SCORECARDS FOR THAT COURT, FOR THE DURATION OF THE DAY.

Updated results will be available on MyNetball only.

## TROPHY PRESENTATION

Presentation of trophies will be held in the carpark area between the clubhouse and courts 5 and 6. There will be two presentation times and divisions will be presented as follows:

Teams involved in the final game for their division are asked to hurry the scorecards to the office please, so that results may be finalised.

Ten (10) medallions will be presented for Winners and Runners-up in each division. If any team has more than ten players then extra medallions can be arranged – please advise us before leaving. No medallions will be distributed prior to the Trophy Presentation.

Two (2) points will be allocated for a win, one (1) for a draw, zero (0) for a loss. The overall winner and runners-up will be the team with the highest points at the conclusion of the games.

In the event of two teams being tied on points at the conclusion of the carnival, final placings will be determined by the head-to-head result between the teams involved in the tie. If that result was a draw, or if the teams played each other multiple times and the result was inconclusive, then final placings will be determined by the highest goaling percentage (goals for/goals against x 100) and as displayed on mynetball ladder.

In the event of three or more teams being tied on points at the conclusion of the carnival, final placings will be determined by the highest goaling percentage only and head to head results will not be considered.

## FOOD

There are many different food options available including our BBQ, Canteen and ever popular Cake Stall. **These facilities**

**will accept cash and eftpos.** These are all set up in between the clubhouse and courts 5 and 6. There are also two coffee vans and Dippin' Dots and Acai Brothers. Please see the map attached with the vendors locations.

## **TOILETS**

The main female toilet block is located on the low (south) side of the clubhouse near the patio area. The men's toilets are situated at the high (north) side of the clubhouse near the bottom of court 3. We have several port-a-loos located in the fenced-off car park area near court 4. We understand that the main toilet block can get busy and therefore encourage you to use the additional toilets.

## **TENT SET UP**

Associations and supporters are able to set up their tents in any areas surrounding the courts (unless otherwise indicated). The Council regulations stipulate that **under no circumstances are tent pegs to be driven into the Council parklands. Please be aware of this if you are setting up tents in this area. Please use sandbags or other weights if required. No vehicles are able to be driven up to the court area from the Allan/Batten St entry.**

There is to be no BBQ, cooking or open flames on the grounds. Rubbish bins are located around the park. Please help keep our grounds clean.

## **WARM UP AREA**

Teams may warm up on the grassed area in Bradbury Park or in the roped-off carpark area near the port-a-loos only. This area will not be used for car parking and is designated for warm-up. Teams are not to warm-up in the general or Bowls Club carpark areas, which are not designated for warm-up. This is a safety issue and we strongly discourage coaches from warming teams up in these areas.
